## International Pharmacy Practice Rotation Program

### I Introduction

This pharmacy practice rotation program is jointly designed by China Pharmaceutical and Nanjing Drum Tower Hospital to provide international students with an opportunity for study of the practice of Pharmacy in China. The rotations are intense, concentrated and highly experiential, and students will be faced with many real problems involving the care of actual patients under the supervision of a preceptor. Students will break away from the academic routine and expand their worldview, gain confidence in handling the unexpected, and learn invaluable problem-solving skills applicable to any professional environment. Moreover, the program will enable students to enhance their knowledge of the differences and similarities between China and their own countries and gain a better understanding of the impact of culture on health beliefs, the delivery of health care services, and the provision of pharmaceutical care.



### II Time

The program will last for six weeks and the timing block can be finalized as per the agreement between two universities.

1. Fourth year Pharm D students and healthy
2. Non-Chinese nationals
